## Open your heart to God!



Prayer is the foundation of our Lenten disciplines. Without prayer our fasting, self-denial, penance and almsgiving will not make for a fruitful Lent. Without prayer we simply will not be closer to God at Easter than we were on Ash Wednesday. Our penitential practices will not have any meaning beyond going through the motions, and we know from all the Scripture readings at Mass during Lent that the last thing Jesus wants us to do is go through the motions like the scribes and Pharisees did in their religious practices!

To pray is to allow ourselves to be loved by God and to converse with him from the depths of our hearts. The Sacraments are prayer. We worship the Lord in spirit and in truth at the Mass when we listen to the Word of God in the Scripture and praise God the Father through Jesus, in the Holy Spirit. We glorify the Lord's mercy in the Sacrament of Penance when we confess our sins with a humble and contrite heart.

From the treasuries of the Church we have devotional prayers such as the Rosary and the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. These, too, are conversations with God if we allow them to be. We can meditate on the profound love of God in the Mysteries of the Rosary while we recall the important events of Christ's earthly life.

I would like to suggest several ways we can truly practice the presence of God in prayer. First, if you have a commute to work, consider praying the Rosary or the Chaplet of Divine Mercy on your drive to work. It certainly will make your trip more peaceful and will most likely make your work day more peaceful as well. Another way is to repeat a prayer called "The Jesus Prayer." The prayer is like the prayer of the Publican in Luke 18:9-14 — "Lord, Jesus Christ, Son of the Living God, have mercy on me a sinner." If we repeat this prayer as often as we think of it, we will truly open our heart to God grace and love. Then this Lent will be the most fruitful Lent of our lives!
